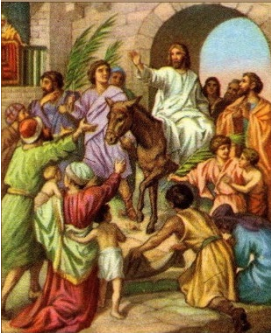


“Hosannah!”

This was a **huge** fulfillment of prophecy. (Matthew 21:4)

Expectations: Two **big** ones.

The people wanted it to be a **physical** fulfillment of prophecy. (Matthew 21:5)

- A. A **militant** king.
- B. A **deliverer** from oppression.

Jesus, at this time, is offering only a **spiritual** fulfillment of prophecy.

- A. Jesus **weeps!** (Luke 19:41)
- B. People **missed** it. (Matthew 21:10)

Jesus answers the one question people are still asking today, “**who** is this?” (Matthew 21:11)

- A. “That was **revealed** to you by my Father.” (Matthew 16:17-19)
- B. This Passover week, ask **Jesus** to **reveal** Himself to you!

Next Week

Title: “He is not here! He is risen!”

Text: Luke 24:1-12

Questions: Have you ever been in shock? The dazzling appearance of angels, like at Jesus’ birth, are now present at His resurrection. Do you suppose the other eleven were thinking this were an idle tale? (vs. 11) Isn’t it interesting that Jesus’ resurrection was perfectly scripted in Scripture? (vs. 6-8)
