Sandy Bay Lighthouse Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational, Christian organization that exists to address the needs of the underprivileged people of Roatan, Honduras.

- We provide a loving, safe shelter for at-risk children.
- We provide a quality bilingual Christian education at our **Beacon School** for children both in our Home and in the wider community, to prepare them for a secure future.
- We provide opportunities for short-term mission teams. These are life-changing ministry opportunities for small groups to work on our campus and in the local communities.

Serving the people of Roatan through children's, youth, adult ministry, service ministry (construction), church, prayer, school & evangelism. Services provided depend on team size and abilities.

Cost (Overestimated) = \$1800

\$850 + air fare (\$700-\$900)

- Deposit: **\$100 (non-refundable) & commitment form due on May 18, 2023** (8 months prior to trip date. Forfeited funds will go towards the short term mission group fund.)
- First payment of **\$350 is due on July 18, 2023** (6 months prior).
- Final Payment of **\$400 is due on November 18, 2023** (2 months prior)
- Airfare/insurance payment (**estimate \$700-900**) **is due at time of booking July/ August 2023** (5 months prior). Flights will be arranged by the group leader.

Funds are non- refundable unless an approved doctor's note is given to CCC, an emergency & or death. Funds can be transferred to the team for use of supplies and or saved for your future mission trip with CCC.

Fundraising will be determined once the team has been established.

MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Minister to children through leading kids' clubs, Vacation Bible School, puppet shows, crafts, Bible stories, sports, skits, and games.

SERVICE MINISTRY

Live out the gospel through your work on various projects, such as painting, roofing, cement work, tiling, or any other numerous needs of your host partner. Check with your consultant on service project costs (ministry money).

CHURCH MINISTRY

Worship alongside a local church and participate by providing special music, sermons, testimonies, or help lead Sunday School.

PRAYER MINISTRY

Bless communities through times of intercessory prayers during prayer walks or pray with local churches at prayer meetings.

SCHOOL MINISTRY

During the school year, minister at local schools by leading devotions, tutoring students, observing classes, or participating in recess.

MERCY MINISTRY

Be the hands and feet of Christ as you visit and minister to those that live in children's homes, hospitals, prisons, senior centers, and homeless shelters.

EVANGELISM MINISTRY

Assist the local church in outreach by handing out Bibles, street evangelism, door to door visits, or sharing the gospel in local parks.

YOUTH MINISTRY

Connect directly with youth in the community by leading a youth rally, fellowship night, or worship.

ADULT MINISTRY

Lead parenting classes, Bible studies, or leadership training. As you minister to adults, you are ministering to entire families and communities.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL MINISTRIES

Medical and dental professionals and their talents are needed in some of our locations. If you have this desire and ability, please contact your consultant to begin filling out the necessary paperwork to start this process.

OTHER MINISTRIES

Have a unique ministry that God has blessed you and your team to be able to lead? Let us know and we will work with our host partners to incorporate it into your customized trip.

TESTIMONIES

No matter the ministries you choose, you will be involved in building relationships with those in the community. One of the best ways to prepare your team to serve is by asking them to develop their testimony in a way that can be shared with those you meet. During one of your team meetings, consider taking time to form and practice sharing testimonies. Below is a guide to help your team.

Testimonies paint a picture of how God is at work in our lives.

You can share:

- How you came to follow Jesus
- God's hand at work during specific moments of your own life
- Ways God reveals Himself in the world around you

Practice your testimony ahead of time to be ready to share should the opportunity present itself. As we reveal ourselves to others, they often feel comfortable in revealing themselves to us. This can open the door to deeper conversations and questions.

Some tips as you prepare:

- Write down your testimony. You may not stick exactly to it, but it will help you form the flow of how you want to share your story.
- Think of ways to relate to those you are going to serve. Are there some areas of need in the community that the host partner has alerted you to? Maybe there's a time in your life where you experienced something similar.
- While there are moments where you will only have a moment to share, or times when you can really expound on your testimony, practice a testimony about 5-7 minutes in length.
- At meetings, plan some time to share testimonies in front of one another. Not only is it good practice, you may learn a lot about those you are going to serve alongside.
