There are four lessons we can learn from the Samaritan woman.

1. The Samaritan woman scheduled her day to avoid her deepest **pains**. (John 4:1-9)
 - A. Jesus still knows **when** and **where** to meet us in our pain.
 - B. The Samaritan woman would **not** have expected a **conversation**.
2. The Samaritan woman **stayed** with Jesus. (John 4:9-12)
 - A. She didn't run she was **curious**.
 - B. When you stay you can be **filled**.
3. The Samaritan woman **received** His **filling**. (John 4:13-15)
 - A. The giving that Jesus gives is **guaranteed**.
 - B. **Jesus** is the thirst quencher.
4. The Samaritan woman desired to **go** and **do**. (John 4:28-42)
 - A. She immediately went to tell **others**.
 - B. She was changed by true love, Truth, redemption, and peace that led her to **salvation**.
